

DANCES / EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

1. Dances held during the school year will be restricted to high school students. In other words individuals not currently attending high school will not be permitted to attend dances at East Antigonish Academy. The only exception to this rule will be the Prom.
2. Any guest attending the prom will need to have an approved Guest pass. Guest must receive the approval of administration and will be the responsibility of the student who signed them into the prom.
3. Students from other high schools wishing to attend dances at East Antigonish Academy. Must be signed in by 12:00 pm the day of the dance. Only students of East Antigonish Academy may sign students from other schools into a dance. East students are only permitted to sign one student into a dance.
4. Students are not to wear outdoor clothing into the dance area.
5. Once students leave the school building, they will not be readmitted to a dance. Doors close one hour after the dance begins.
6. Alcohol and drugs are strictly prohibited at all school functions. Students who violate this regulation will be denied access to all future school dances for one full calendar year (12 months) and the student will lose their "*Good Standing*". In addition to the suspension The R.C.M.P. and/or parents will be contacted.
7. While representing East Antigonish Academy, students must conduct themselves in an appropriate and responsible manner. All school rules will apply when participating in school sponsored events.
8. Students must be in full attendance in classes the day of an extra-curricular event or dance and also are expected to be in full attendance in class the day following the extra-curricular event. Failure to follow this attendance procedure will result in loss of privilege/good standing.
9. Any incident that results in the loss of good standing at any Strait Regional School Board dance will mean: the student will not be permitted to attend dance one for one calendar year.
10. East Antigonish students who do not follow the rules at another school's dance may be suspended from school depending upon the incident.
